You're Invited to 1st 'Ossining Interacts Night' Saturday, December 1

(OSSINING, N.Y.) – The Ossining High School Interact Club, along with the Ossining Rotary Club and the Ossining Recreation and Parks Department are hosting Ossining's first-ever "Ossining Interacts Night" this Saturday, December 1, at Ossining High School. All are invited to attend.

Students and community members will be showcasing their talents, exciting items will be auctioned off, and the reception will include an impressive buffet.

Proceeds will go toward the purchase of "Shelter Boxes" – tough, green plastic boxes that contain a 10-person tent and ancillary equipment designed to enable a family to survive for at least six months in case of an extreme emergency. A portion of the funds will also benefit cancer research.

The benefit show begins at 7 p.m.; the auction and reception will follow at 9 p.m. Advance adult admission is \$15; \$18 at the door; advance student and seniors admission is \$10; \$12 at the door. "GALA Tickets," which include benefit show, auction, and reception, are \$50.
