The Board of Education is expected to discuss the following topics:

### **“Did You Know That...?” and “We Are Proud That....”**

The Ossining School District focuses upon educating the whole child and facilitating student success. A brief presentation will highlight a number of the achievements attained this year on behalf of students. The achievements include a wide range of accomplishments including but not limited to those in the academic areas, athletics, cultural arts, science research, sustainability, college acceptances, grant awards, community involvement, and staff and student recognitions, among other achievements.

### **Long Range Plan: 2011-2017**

Guided by the Long Range Plan in addition to the annual goals and the overarching District Mission, the District has accomplished a great deal on behalf of students. The current Long Range Plan extends through the 2010-2011 school year. Last year, the foundation for a successor Long Range Plan was developed in a variety of ways including but not limited to recommending topics to be considered for a future Long Range Plan, engaging staff, meeting with groups, and soliciting input. A draft Long Range Plan was released in the Fall of 2010. Revisions to that draft have been included in the updated Draft Long Range Plan to be reviewed during the Board of Education Work Session on 26 April 2011. An update regarding the successor Long Range Plan will be shared. It is projected that a successor Long Range Plan will be adopted in June 2011.

### **Board Action and Community Participation**

Following the Work Session, the Board of Education will conduct its official Business Meeting, during which the Board will take action upon various recommendations of the administration regarding business and personnel items, which will also include taking official action regarding the Putnam/Northern Westchester BOCES Administrative Budget and Election of BOCES Board members.

Members of the school community are encouraged to attend this meeting. Opportunities will be provided for members of the community to raise questions and/or comment about the presentations.

### **Executive Session**

At the end of the Regular Meeting, the Board will meet in Executive Session to discuss personnel.
