## • Ossining School District Budget 2013-2014

The District has been proactive in addressing issues surrounding the preparation of the Ossining School District Budget for the 2013-2014 school year during many Board of Education meetings to date. Deputy Superintendent Mr. Raymond Sanchez and Assistant Superintendent for Business Ms. Alita Zuber will share an overview of communication outreach and community engagement efforts currently underway and those proposed for the reminder of the school year. Mr. Sanchez and Ms. Zuber will highlight a plan for conducting community surveys. Additionally, a variety of options relative to preparing a Proposed District Budget that is fiscally responsible will be shared.
