**1. Call to Order – President**

Board President Bill Kress called the February 26, 2014 Regular Meeting of the Board of Education to order at 7:37 p.m.

**2. Pledge of Allegiance**

Board Trustee Dana Levenberg led all those present in the Pledge of Allegiance.

- Claremont School Artwork has been posted on the District, Facebook and Twitter sites
- Congratulations to OHS student Daniel Cavanagh, winner of the *OHS Digital Learning Day Photo Contest*
- An additional twelve (12) income tax returns have been prepared by students in Ms. Jacoby's accounting class bringing the total of tax returns prepared by students to 35!

**3. Comments from the Student Representative to the Board**

Ossining High School Student Representative to the Board, Ms. Caitlyn Piccirillo, provided the following report:

- OHS student Jessica Chambers was named a finalist in the *National Achievement Scholarship Program*.
- OHS student Dan Scantianu was named a *2014 National Merit Scholarship Competition Finalist*.
- OHS student Alex Delacruz is one of only 11 locally ranked in New York State for Varsity Wrestling.
- OHS student Jalay Knowles reached her 1000+ points career as a Junior! She was nationally recognized in an MSG Varsity article and is one of Sports Illustrated's *Faces in the Crowd*!
- Both Ossining Boys' and Girls' Basketball teams were in the playoffs. The girls' team will be playing in the sectional semifinals tomorrow, February 27<sup>th</sup> at 4:45 at the Westchester County Center.
- OHS students Alex Delacruz, Clayton Francis, Isiah Beltran, Yamadin Brown and Alex Dago qualified for varsity wrestling sectionals! Alex Delacruz will be going on to compete in the 2014 NYSPHSAA Wrestling Championships.

- Students in the OHS math circle have been competing with Hendrick Hudson and Peekskill in a math competition each month since October 2013. Five students from our math circle will be moving on to the second level of competition in White Plains on March 3, 2014. Congratulations to Juliet Ivanov and Luke Martin for having the highest scores in the most recent competition.
- OHS Art teacher, Mr. Ronald Whitehead, created a painting that now resides in the US Court of Appeals!
- Juniors and seniors from the Science Research program competed at the Westchester-Rockland Junior Science and Humanities Symposium on February 8<sup>th</sup>. In the poster competition, separated by categories Stephanie Becker, Herc DeGuzman, and David Leibert won 3<sup>rd</sup> place; Elizabeth Keeley won 2<sup>nd</sup> place; and Juliet Ivanov, Adam Krupinski, Brinda Ramesh, Luke Vutera, and Lucia Tonelli won 1<sup>st</sup> place.

In the overall poster session competition, Ossining swept with 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place winners: Juliet Ivanov, Brinda Ramesh, and Adam Krupinski, respectively. We also have the highest number of students from a single school competing at the 2014 Upstate JSHS in Albany, which is scheduled to be held on March 10-11, 2014. We have 5 speakers: Claudia Guinansaca-Aguilar, Ben Ross, Dan Scantieanu, Abby Kamen, and Adam Illowsky. We also have 3 poster presenters: Maria Walsh-Regotti, Jared Annibale, and Caitlin Piccirillo-Stosser. Congratulations to the entire Science Research program on all their hard work and good luck to them at the upstate JSHS competition!

- The grand re-opening of the OHS auditorium was held Tuesday evening, February 4<sup>th</sup>. This featured performances by the drumline, band, chorus, and orchestra and offered a sneak peek of the spring musical *Legally Blonde* which will be performed in the new OHS auditorium April 3<sup>rd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup>! Admission is free but donations are always welcome.
- On February 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> members of the Ossining High School Junior States of America attended the Winter Congress in Washington D.C.
- Sophomore Parent Night was held last night, February 25<sup>th</sup> at OHS. Junior course offerings and PSAT scores were discussed.
- Unfortunately, since Valentine's Day was a snow day, the Senior Citizens Breakfast was cancelled. Luckily, this past Monday, February 24<sup>th</sup> was declared "Valentine's Day" at Ossining High School. Seniors handed out candy-grams (lollipops), carnations and performed singing-grams as part of a class-based fundraiser.

#### **5. Work Session**

##### **5.1 District Budget 2014-2015**

Superintendent of Schools Mr. Raymond Sanchez and Assistant Superintendent for Business Ms. Alita Zuber provided an interactive budget "workshop" made up of puzzle pieces

representing proposed budget priorities and encouraged everyone in the audience to participate in this exercise. The purpose of this interactive exercise was to gauge from the community what it considered most important to include in the development of the school district budget for the 2014-2015 school year.

District priorities for the 2014-2015 school year include the following:

- Solvency
- Safety
- Space

Community members were divided into groups of eight (8) to ten (10) people per table and were given approximately a half hour to share thoughts and ideas and to select those “puzzle” pieces which represented what they felt were most important and should be considered during the budget development. Results showed that maintaining classroom size and expanding or adding classroom space were top priorities.

Mr. Sanchez thanked everyone for participating in the puzzle exercise and encouraged everyone to attend the All Day Budget Meeting on Saturday, March 8, 2014 in the Ossining High School Library.

Board discussion took place. The Board thanked Mr. Sanchez and Ms. Zuber for this creative and interactive exercise which offered the community a look into the budget process. The Board thanked the community for taking an active role in the puzzle exercise and for sharing their thoughts. The results of this evening’s exercise will aid the administration in the development of the budget.

**5.2 Review of Final Report from the Budget Advisory Committee**

Assistant Superintendent for Business Ms. Alita Zuber provided an overview of the work of the members of the Budget Advisory Committee and their advocacy efforts with regard to Foundation Aid. The community is encouraged to continue advocacy efforts and to contact legislators to encourage them to consider restoring Foundation Aid to the District, which has been frozen at 2007-2008.

**6. Public Hearing: Proposed Veterans Tax Exemption**

Board President Mr. Bill Kress opened the Public Hearing regarding the proposed Veterans tax exemption.

Superintendent of Schools Mr. Raymond Sanchez and Assistant Superintendent for Business Ms. Alita Zuber via a PowerPoint presentation reviewed the recent amendment made by Governor Andrew Cuomo on or about December 18, 2013 to the NYS Real Property Law, Sec. 458-a. Counsel was present to answer questions from the Board and from the audience. The amendment is a new extension of the legislature to school district taxes which did not exist before. Town of Ossining Tax Assessor Mr. Fernando Gonzalez was present to answer questions and explain how this change would affect the tax rolls going forward.

The deadline for veterans to file applications with the Town of Ossining Tax Assessor’s Office for the exemption is June 1, 2014 and would affect the tax rolls for the 2015 tax year. The way the law is currently written may require further clarification by the Governor, but counsel advised that once the District opts in to the Veterans tax exemption, it will remain in place going forward to the future. Counsel also advised that a District may modify or opt out of the decision to extend the extension in the future if it deems it to be in the best interest of the District.
